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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

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This report focuses on the employment and educational outcomes of **321** students who graduated from Peirce College in August 2022, December 2022, and May 2023. 352 degrees were conferred to 321 unique graduates. Data was obtained from **321** graduates, which represents **100%** of the individuals who graduated during this time period.

Of the graduates who responded with their employment status, **243 (76%) are employed**, with the majority (**211 of 243 who specified answers, or 87%) employed in a position related to their field of study**. In comparison with the 2021-2022 graduating class, this is a 2% increase in employment and 15% increase in employment within field of study.

**80%** of responding graduates indicated that they earned a base salary over **\$40,000** annually, a 6% improvement from the 2021-2022 graduating class and a 15% improvement from 2020-2021. **40%** of 2022-2023 graduates reported make over **\$60,000**, compared to just 29% of 2021-2022 graduates. The approximate average salary for the class of 2022-2023 is **\$58,266**.

Top employers for the 2022-2023 graduating class were Penn Medicine (16 employees), the City of Philadelphia (13 employees), JetBlue Airways (8 employees), and Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (7 employees).

59% of responding graduates were planning to enroll or already were enrolled in continuing education. This represents a 5% increase from the previous year.

## METHODOLOGY

### Data Collection

The graduate surveys were previously reviewed by Faculty Chairs to ensure that relevant information was collected in order to gain needed information for accreditation by the Association of College Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP) and approval by the American Bar Association (ABA).

Surveys were deployed electronically to graduates several times throughout the year. As needed, additional information may be collected via phone calls, email, and LinkedIn.

### Data Presentation

The percentages for number of students employed and those employed within their field of concentration were tabulated. Comparisons have been made between 2023-21 and the preceding year in order to evaluate outcomes as a group with reference to individual majors. The number of graduates, the number of respondents, their employment status, and educational transfer patterns were compared.

Data reflect self-reported results from graduates that reflect the following areas of study:

## 2022-2023 GRADUATE SURVEY OVERALL SYNOPSIS

The 2022-2023 Graduate Employment Survey was deployed to **321** graduates, and information was collected for **321 (100%)** graduates.

Figure 1. All graduates by program.

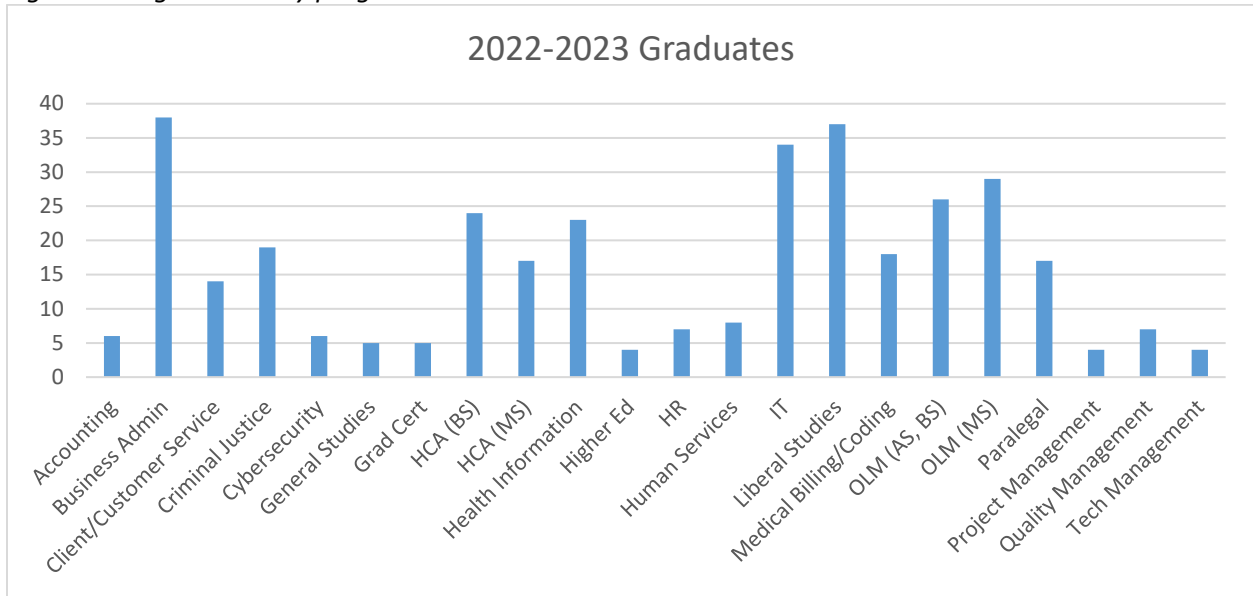
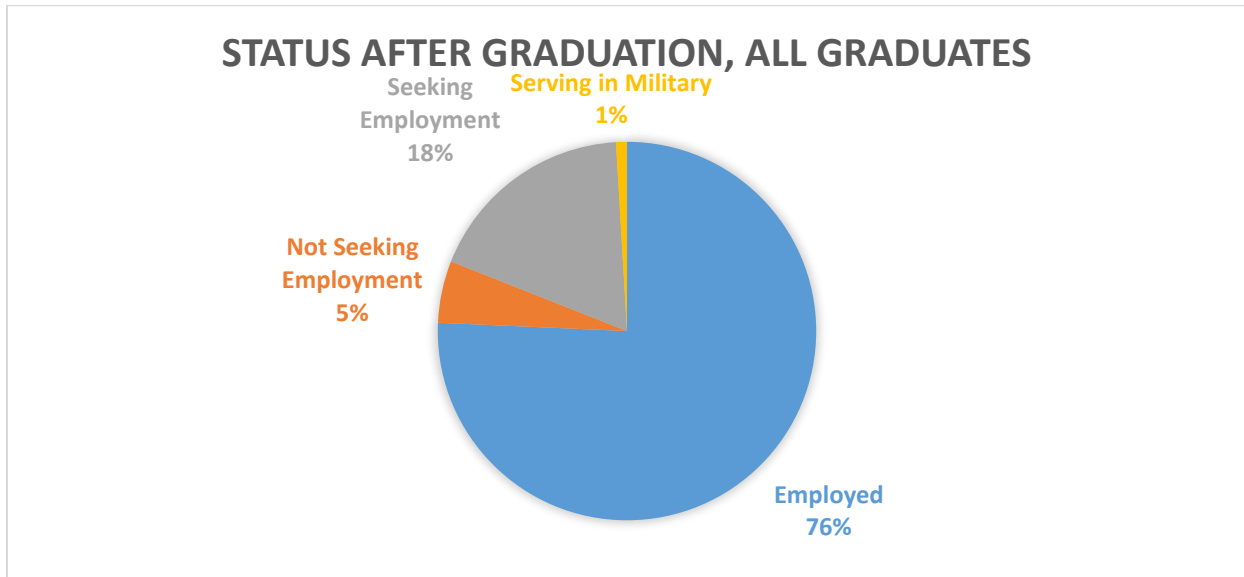


Figure 2. Status after Graduation, All Graduates.

Figure 3. Employment rates by program.

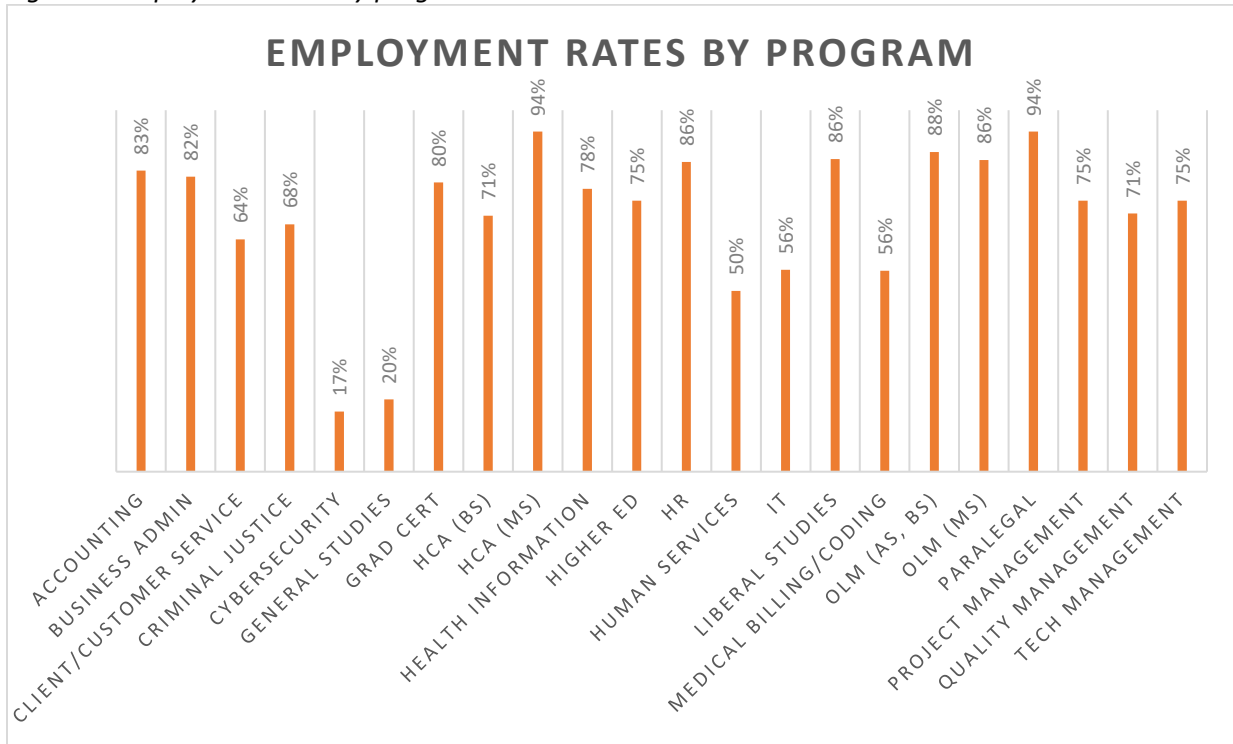
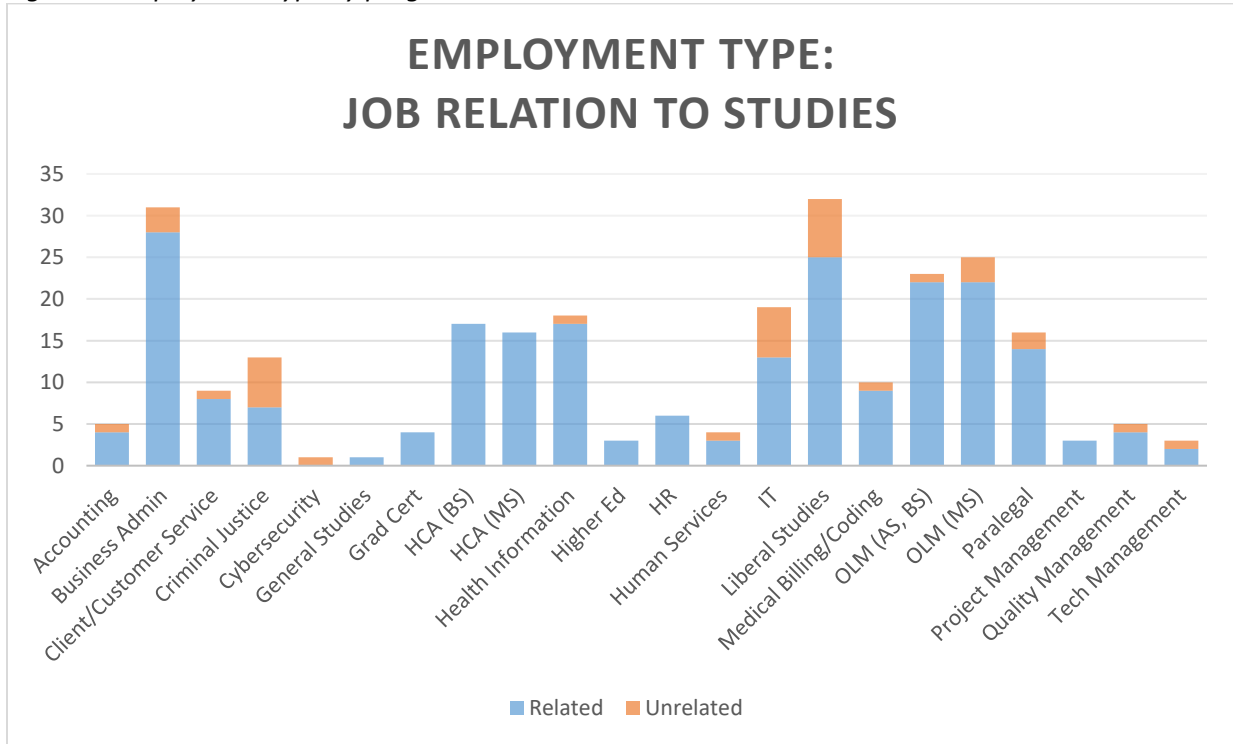
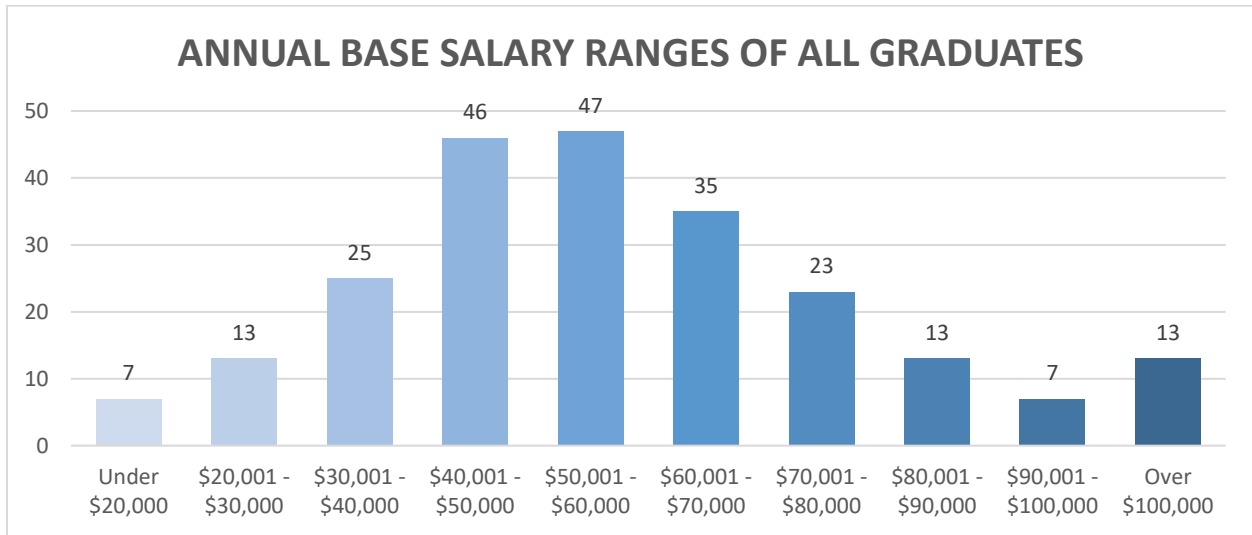


Figure 4. Employment type by program.



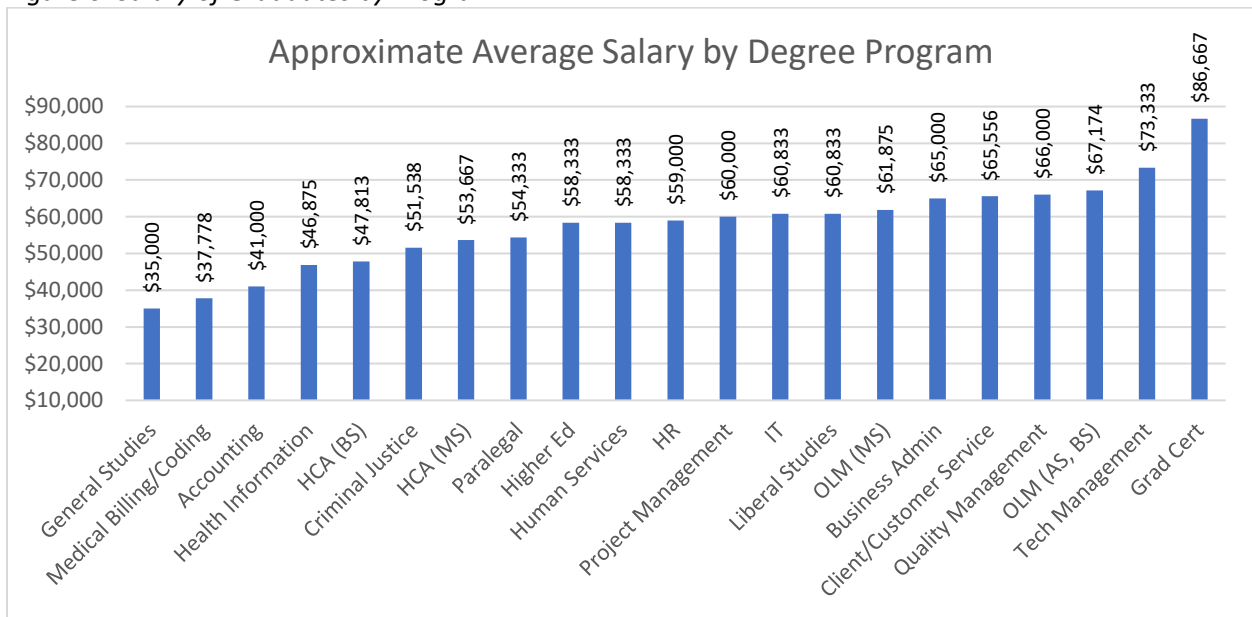
Of those respondents who are working and indicated their employment type (employed in the field or elsewhere), the majority of respondents are employed in a field related or somewhat related to their studies.

40% of 2022-2023 graduates reported make over \$60,000, compared to just 29% of 2021-2022 graduates. 80% make over \$40,000, a 6% improvement from the 2021-2022 graduating class and a 15% improvement from 2020-2021.

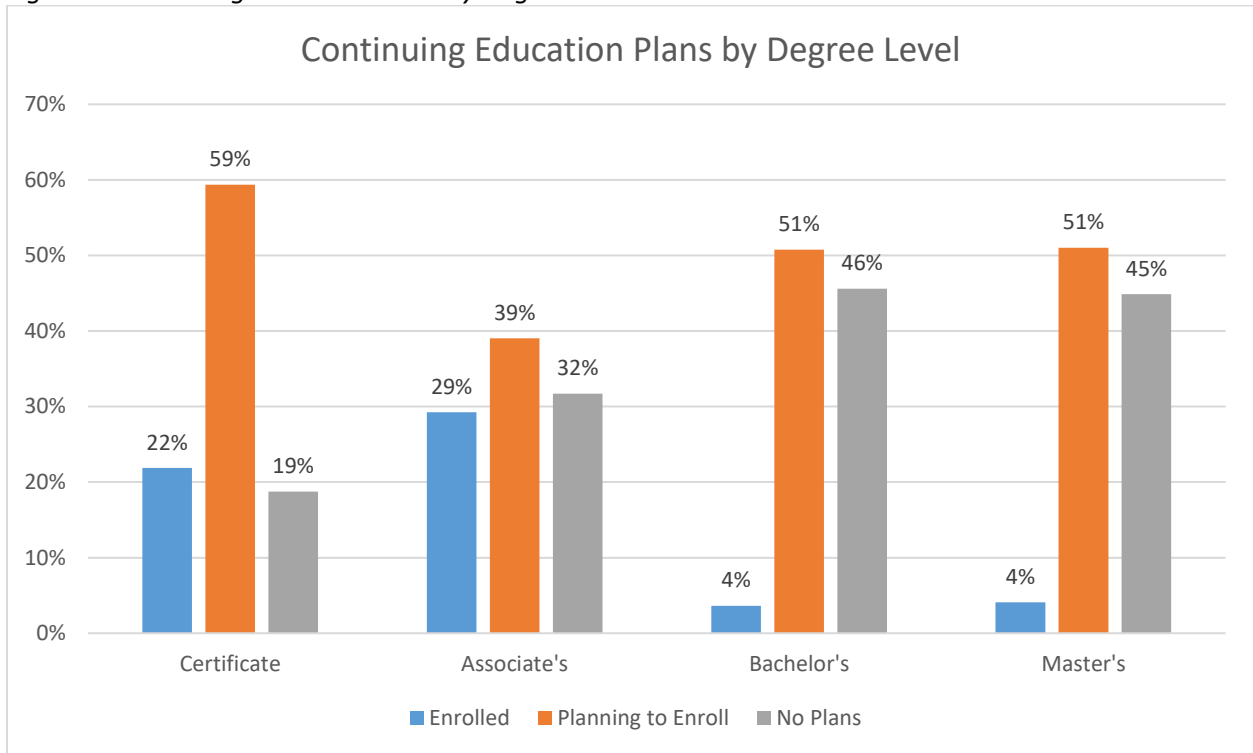


## CONTINUING EDUCATION

Survey recipients were asked about their plans related to continuing education. 50% of graduates who responded to the question planned to enroll in further education, 9% were already enrolled, and 41% had no plans to enroll.

Of the 28 students who reported that they were already enrolled; the majority (23 individuals, or 82% of those who provided information) are continuing to pursue their educational goals at Peirce College, with the remaining enrolled at St. Joseph's University (1), Pennsylvania State University (1), DeVry University (1), South University (1), and Western Governors University (1).

Figure 7. Continuing Education Plans by Degree Level.

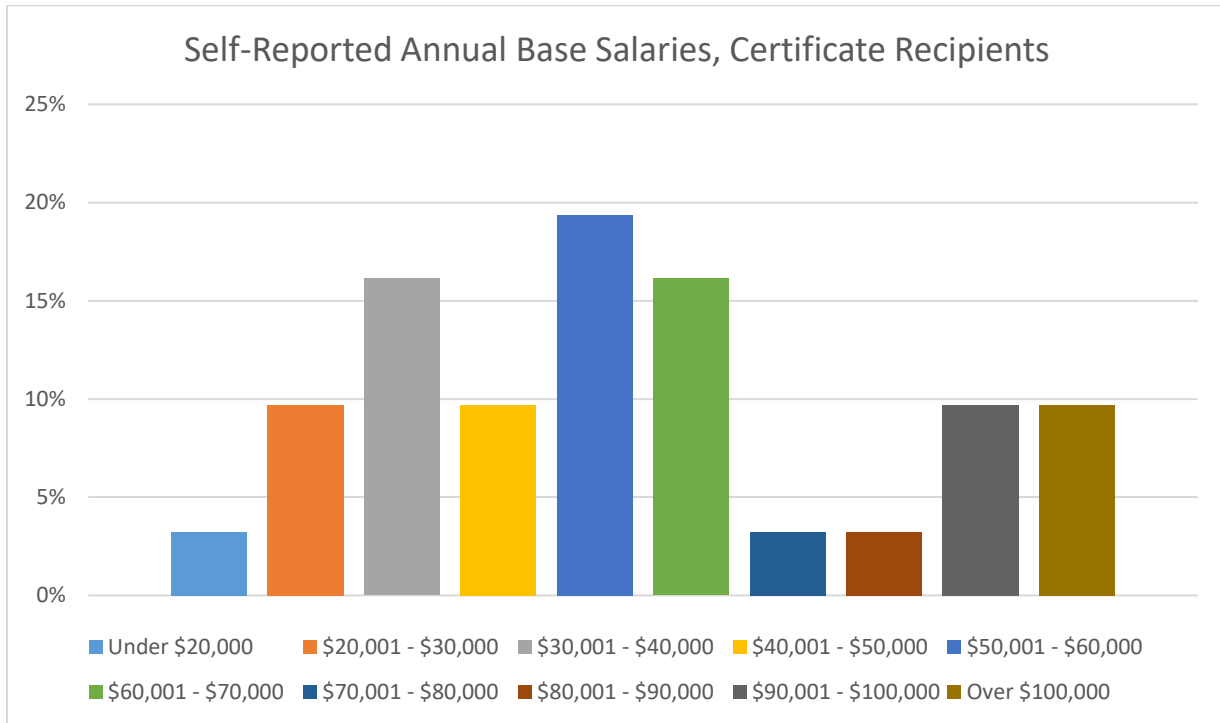


### Certificate Graduates

62 certificates were conferred in the 2022-2023 academic year. Surveys were sent to all certificate graduates with a 100% response rate. Annual base salary data was collected for 14 graduates. **58% are employed, 34%, are seeking employment, and 4% are not seeking employment. 86% respondents are employed within their field of concentration.**

Certificates were conferred for the following programs: Medical Coding (17), Client Services (13), Quality Service Management (7), Cybersecurity (6), Project Management Administration (4), Graduate Certificate in Operations Management (4), Human Resource Management (3), IT Support (3), Paralegal Studies (2), Graduate Certificate in Higher Education Leadership (1), Customer Service (1), and Medical Billing (1).

Figure 8. Reported salaries of certificate program graduates.

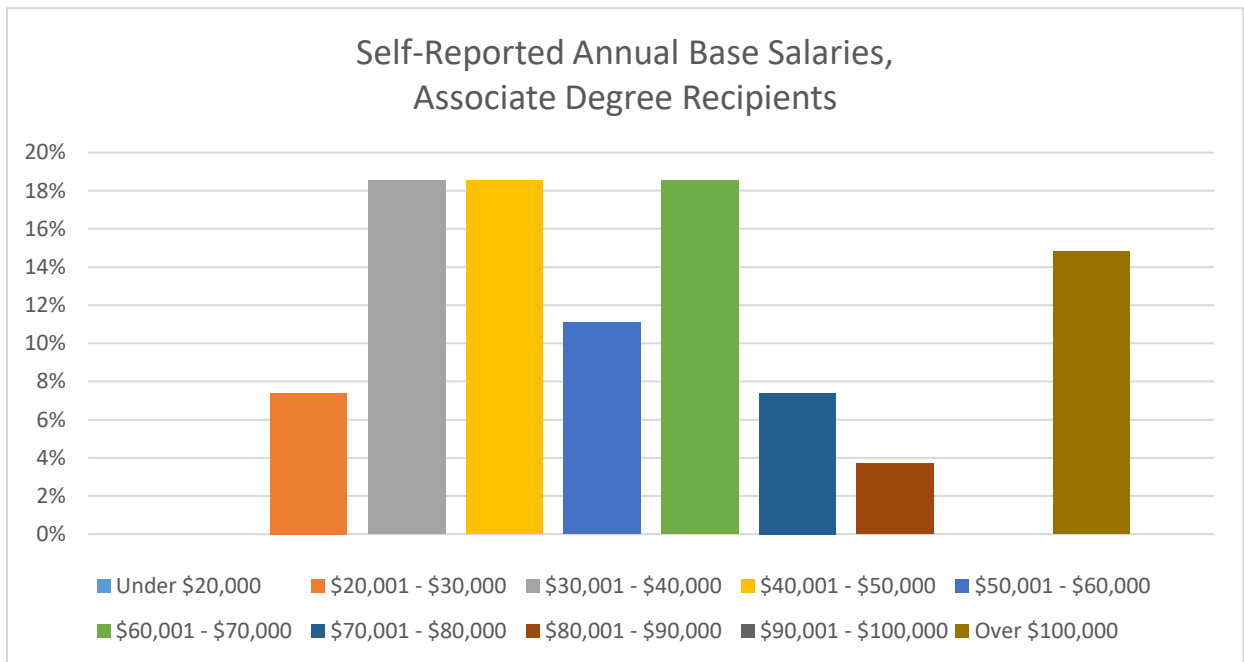


## Associate Degree Graduates

45 associate degrees were conferred in 2022-2023. Surveys were sent to all with a response rate of 100%. Annual base salary data was collected for 25 graduates. **64% are employed, 20% are seeking employment, 13% are not seeking employment, and 2% are serving in the military. 90% are employed within their field of concentration.**

Associate degrees were conferred for the following programs: Health Information Technology (14), Business Administration (11), Leadership Development (7), Information Technology (6), General Studies (5), Criminal Justice (1), and Paralegal Studies (1).

## Bachelor Degree Graduates

**195** bachelor's degrees were conferred in 2022-2023. Responses were collected from all graduates. **79% are employed, 16% seeking employment, 4% not seeking employment, and 1% serving in the military. 84% are employed within a field related to their degree.**

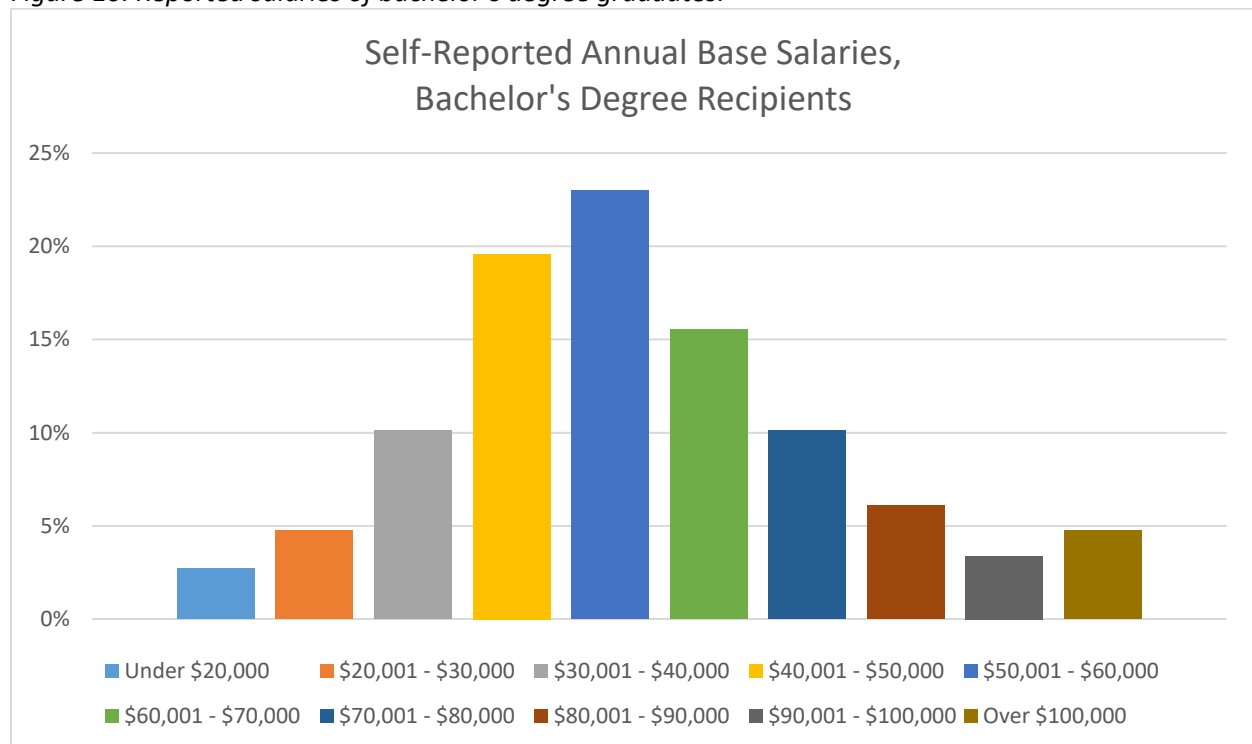
The 195 bachelor's degree program graduates earned degrees in the following programs: Liberal Studies (37), Business Administration (27), Information Technology (25), Healthcare Administration (24), Organizational Leadership and Management (19), Criminal Justice (18), Paralegal (14), Health Information Administration (9), Human Services Leadership (8), Accounting (6), Technology Management (4), and HR (4).

The 37 Liberal Studies Bachelor of Arts graduates earned their degree in the following tracks: Management (12), Criminal Justice (6), Leadership (6), Cybersecurity (5), Human Resource Management (3), Customer Service Management (2), General Business (1), Quality Service Management (1), Medical Coding (1).

12 of the 27 Business Administration Bachelor of Science graduates earned their degree with a concentration: Management (10) and Entrepreneurship/Small Business Management (2).

14 of the 25 Information Technology B.S. graduates earned their degree with a concentration: Networking, Admin, & Information Security (11) and Programming and Application Development (3).

Figure 10. Reported salaries of bachelor's degree graduates.

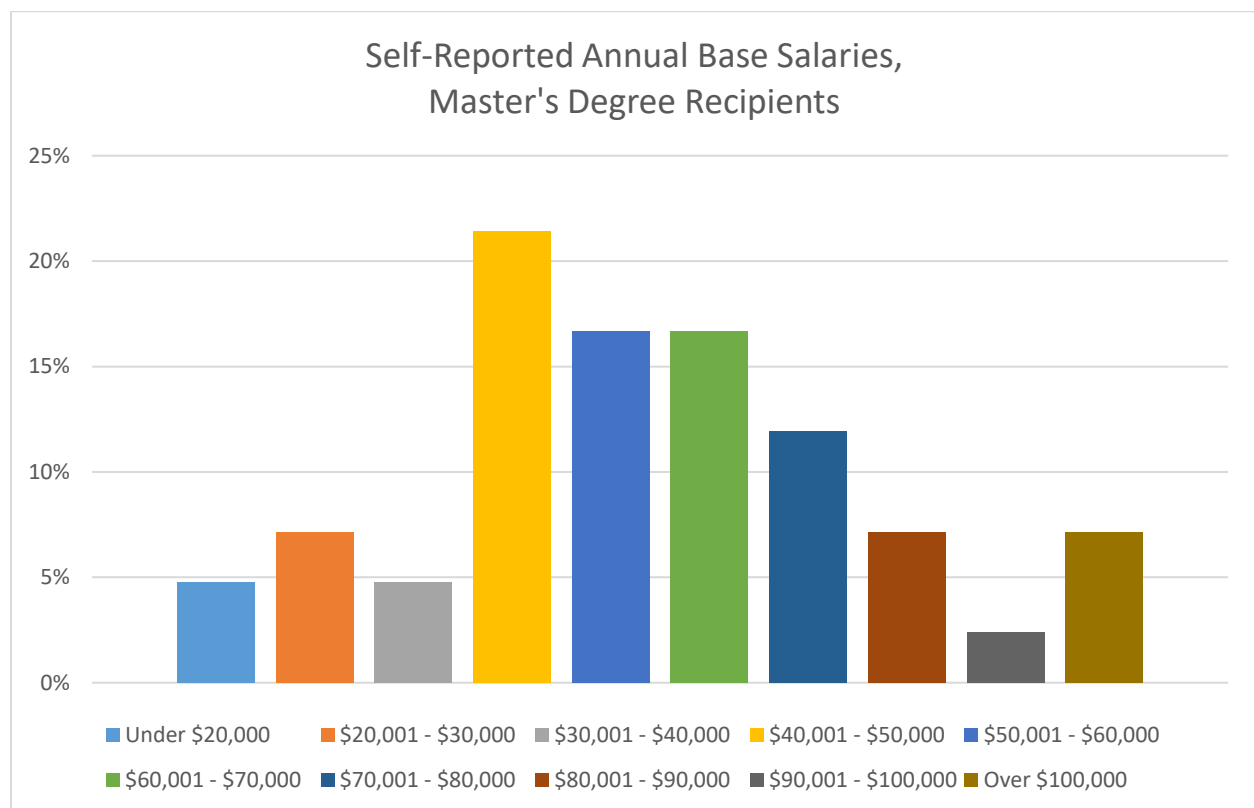


## Master of Science Degree Graduates

50 Master of Science (M.S.) degrees were conferred in 2022-2023. Responses were collected from all graduates. **88% are employed, 8% are seeking employment, and 4% are not seeking employment. 95% are employed within their field of study.**

29 graduates received a master's degree in Organizational Leadership & Management, 17 received a master's degree in Healthcare Administration, and 4 received a degree in Higher Education Leadership. Of those who received a master's degree in Higher Education Leadership, 3 had a focus in Enrollment Management & Student Services and 1 had a focus in Instructional Technology & Online Learning. Of those who received a master's degree in Organizational Leadership & Management, 1 had a focus in Operations Management and 1 received the degree posthumously.

## THREE-YEAR COMPARISON: 2020-2021, 2021-2022, AND 2022-2023 EMPLOYMENT RATES

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The three-year comparison highlights only the current degree programs and concentrations offered by Peirce. This review includes associate and bachelor's degrees in Accounting, Business Administration, Criminal Justice Studies, General Studies, Healthcare Administration, Health Information Administration, Health Information Technology, Human Resource Management, Human Services Leadership, Information Technology, Liberal Studies, Organizational Leadership, Paralegal Studies, and Technology Management as well as certificate programs in Client/Customer Service, Cybersecurity, Higher Education Leadership (graduate), Human Resource Management, Information Technology, Medical Billing, Medical Coding, Operations Management (graduate), Paralegal Studies, Project Management, and Quality Service Management and master's degrees in Healthcare Administration, Higher Education Leadership, and Organizational Leadership and Management. Specifically, the report includes statistics related to the number of graduates, the number responding to survey, the number employed, and the number employed in their field of study.

For the **2022-2023** academic year, 321 students graduated within the degree programs and concentrations identified. Of the 321, 100% responded to the survey, though some survey questions were left blank. Excluding non-respondents, 243 (76%) are employed and 211 (87%) reported that they are employed within their field of study.

For the **2021-2022** academic year, 299 students graduated within the degree programs and concentrations identified. Of the 299, 99% responded to the survey, though some survey questions were left blank. Excluding non-respondents, 219 (74%) are employed and 158 (73%) reported that they are employed within their field of study.

For the **2020-2021** academic year, 304 students graduated within the degree programs and concentrations identified. Of the 304, 98.6% responded to the survey, though some survey questions were left blank. Excluding non-respondents, 209 (70%) were employed and 160 (77%) reported that they were employed within their field of study.

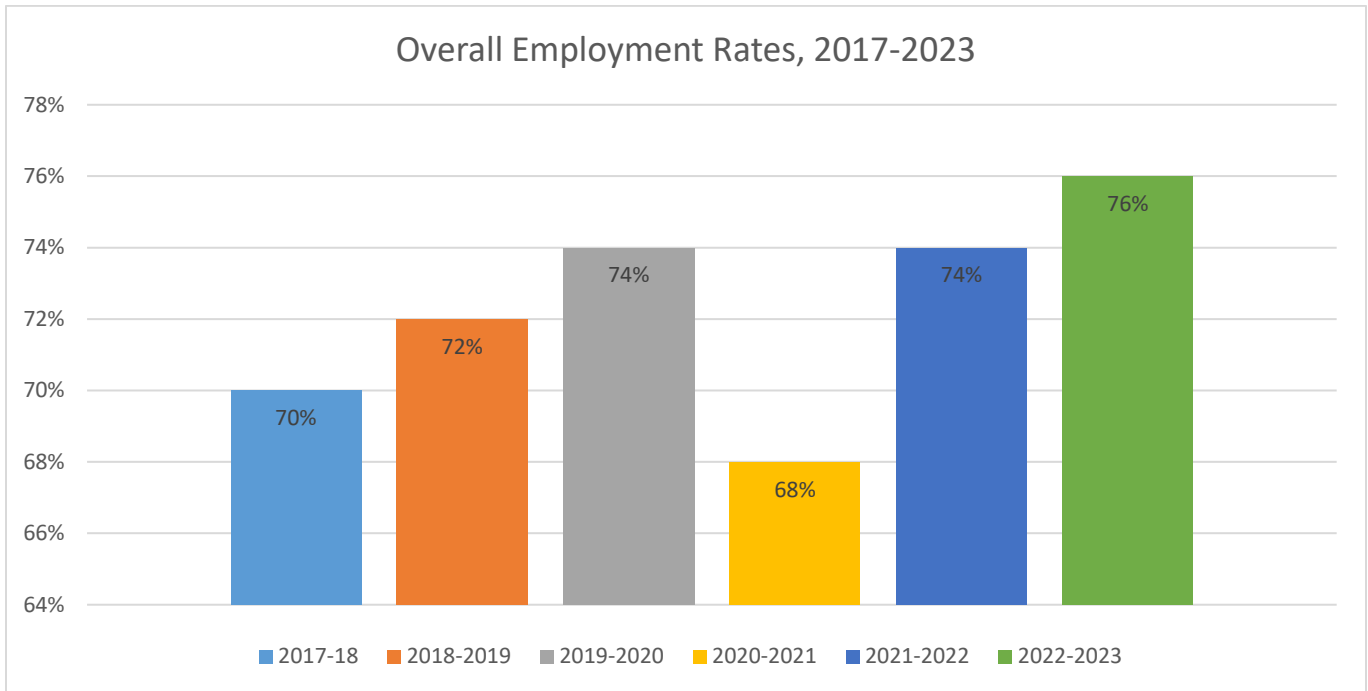
